MINUTES OF MEETING 4-H Council

The Marion County 4-H Council was held on June 8th, 2020 7:00 p.m. via Zoom.

The meeting was called to order. Roll call was answered by 17 attendees, and extension agents Rickey Roberts and Tristen Cope.

The April Minutes were read by Karsen Kroupa. Minutes approved as read.

Communications: None.

The April Treasurer's Report: The Treasurers report was read by Morgan Gaines. Morgan reported a beginning balance of \$13, 690.65. 4-H Council had an income of \$55.00 and expenses in the amount of \$409.63 for a subtotal of \$20,354.08. Including Shorting Sports (\$510.00 income), County Fair Awards, Lazy Days Swine Classic, Spring Beef Show, and the Cody Pankratz Memorial Accounts, 4-H Council has a balance of \$28, 764.81.

Committee Reports:

Style Revue Committee: The Style Revue Committee reported the theme will be, "Time for the 20's: Come have a roaring good time.". They discussed the new addition to the public style revue (non-judged) of formal wear. If you have a formal dress from the 1920's era please contact Addie Berens or Extension Office.

Unfinished Business: Marion County Extension and Dickinson County Extension have sent the Districting Documents to the State and are awaiting final approval from the Attorney General Office. Raffle Tickets: Club Leaders will be passing out Raffle Tickets from the Marion County 4H Endowment Fund. This is a fundraiser for the Endowment Fund to support funding for 4H Events, Scholarships, Projects, ect.
