Dickinson County 4-H Bucket Calf Guidelines

Hopefully you've been able to spend lots of time with your bucket calves! Here's a few reminders:

- Bucket calves must be born on or after January 1, current year.
- Bucket calves are **not** tagged with an official 4-H tag.
- IMPORTANT: By May 1 you must complete a Bucket Calf Identification form with a photo or hand-colored picture of your calf and submit it to the Extension Office.
- The **completed** form may be:
 - 1) mailed to the office (712 S Buckeye, Abilene, KS 67410),
 - 2) emailed to chisholmtrail@listserv.ksu.edu, or
 - 3) left in our drop box at the office.

- If you are caring for more than one calf as part of your project, please identify all calves, just in case.
- Study the body parts of your calf using the Color a Rainbow Calf activity, attached and found at https://www.chisholmtrail.k- state.edu/4 h/forms and applications/dickinson forms apps/index.html
- Looking toward summer, bucket calves must be pre-entered online at http://ckff.fairentry.com/ for the Central Kansas Free Fair by July 10
