Horse identification forms must be submitted to the Extension Office for an agent signature by May 1 each year. This is a state requirement and there will be NO EXCEPTIONS! We will NOT accept late forms.

The Horse Identification Certificate (P-1039 rev.) needs to be completed for every horse you plan to show this 4-H year. The form may be picked up from the Extension Office or found online at <https://bookstore.ksre.ksu.edu/pubs/P1039.pdf>

You will not be allowed to show horses that are not identified by May 1. If you intend to participate at the District and/or State 4-H Horse Show, please make sure you are using the new form.
