

## Marion County 4-H Development Fund Scholarship Application

## **Scholarship Eligibility Requirements:**

- 1. Currently enrolled as an active Marion County 4-H Member.
- 2. Enrolled as a 4-H Member for at least five years.
- 3. Entering College for the first time as a full-time undergraduate student.
- 4. Extensive 4-H leadership at the local and county levels and/or Key Award winner.
- 5. Demonstrated problem-solving and leadership capabilities

## **Scholarship Process:**

- 1. **Complete Marion County 4-H Development Fund Scholarship Application.** Typed applications are preferred. If handwritten, application must be legible.
- 2. A letter of recommendation from high school personnel or club leader.
- 3. **One-page single spaced summary** of 4-H leadership, community service, participation, achievements, and recognition. Bullet lists or tables may be used. Start with the most recent accomplishments. Label the 4-H activities: L=Local, C=County, A=Area, R=Regional, S=State, N=National, I=International.
- 4. One-page essay, double spaced, on how "4-H has impacted me".
- 5. A short paragraph about your educational and long-term career goals.
- 6. **Applications and references must be received by Monday, April 1st.** Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
