Delivering SHEEP and MEAT GOATS

 Use the alley to the north, BEHIND the Armory to pull up to the SOUTH end of Barn 2 and unload

Delivering SWINE

- Use the north/south alley that runs parallel to the Small Livestock Arena and Barn 2 off of NW 8th Street
- Enter from the north, exit to the south

Delivering BEEF

 Due to the manure containment area taking up part of Pine Street, there can be no parking, even briefly, on the east side of Pine Street closest to the horse barns. This is by order of the Fire Chief for public safety. We realize it may not be convenient during check-in and check-out, but please don't make this something the fair board has to patrol and chase people down.
