Intent: To recognize an outstanding Marion County 4-H or FFA agriculture- oriented youth.

## **Guidelines/Requirements:**

- 1. Contestants must be a Marion County FFA or 4-H member.
- 2. Contestants in the senior division must be at least 16 years of age but not over 19 years of age as of January 1, 2022.
- 3. Intermediate division contestants must be at least 13 years of age but not over 15 years of age as of January 1, 2022.
- 4. The Superintendent of the contest in cooperation with the contest committee will be in charge of the contest. They shall have the authority for the interpretation of the policies.
- 5. The contestants will be furnished with placing cards, score sheets and any other necessary forms. Contestants should furnish notebook paper and pencils.
- 6. While the contest is in session there SHALL BE NO COMMUNICATION among contestants or anyone other than the group leader.
- 7. Each county fair youth program may enter multiple individuals. Selection and nomination criteria for the individual participating in the Kansas State Fair competition is delegated to the County Fair Board but eligible contestants must be certified by their Agriculture Education instructor (FFA) or Extension Agent (4-H)
